Hello to all,

Well the ARES group was a bit understaffed over the month of August due to a few medical issues, vacations, and the Woodward dream cruise. But despite all of that we did manage to conduct a mini-exercise using VHF simplex and FL-DIGI.

KB8YGA was located in the far north of the county and KD8YUK & KB8TAR were south of the Mason-Dixon line. KD8EBY held down the fort on the 2m repeater. Google Earth returned a distance of 27 miles between the 2 locations.

FL-DIGI traffic was successfully traded all the way down to 5 watts using Yagis at 30' on both ends. We ran into a little trouble when we both switched over to verticals but the digital mode was still able to pass messages at 100% copy.

Overall we were very pleased with the outcome.

In September there will be a District 3 SET and in October there will be a Michigan Section SET - Lapeer ARES will be participating in both. I would like to invite any ham to participate or at least listen in to the proceedings. We do not have the details yet but the dates are in the calendar in this Waveguide. I will keep you posted on these as the details become known.
