Notes From the Desk of the Secretary

Lapeer County Amateur Radio Association - Meeting Minutes - April 10, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by our president, Gerret, KD8YUK. There were 24 members and guests in attendance.

The first order of business was a presentation of D-Star repeater technology by the D-Star group, Mike KQ8N and Terry N8LN from Battle Creek Michigan. D-Star digital repeater can work as a stand-alone digital repeater and be connected via the internet to other online D-Star repeaters to extend the communication footprint throughout the country.

Alternative methods of accessing a D-Star digital repeater without a radio, via DV Dongles and other technologies, using a computer tied to the internet were discussed. Whether you use a D-Star compatible radio into a repeater or an alternative method, all that's required (along with a valid amateur license) is registration to the D-Star data base, a onetime process.

D-Star has been on the market for about 10 years and manufactures' are producing 2nd and 3rd generation equipment.

A second presentation by Lee N8LJ describing the upcoming operating event the Michigan QSO party. Lapeer County is always a popular find by the county hunters.

It was reported that Florence Haack KC8CAB passed away. She was the recording secretary for the Lapeer County Amateur Radio Association for many years.

Meeting minutes from the March 2018 were accepted by the membership present as printed in the Waveguide.

Our treasure Paul AB8XL reported the status of the treasury. His report was approved by the membership present.

Mike KN8Z reported all is well with the repeater systems.

Hello W8LAP Supporters:

There was no activity, relative to the club call (W8LAP).

Repeater issues – Tech Team:

The two meter repeater was reported inoperative on Sunday, April 15, 2018. Preliminary off-site checks showed that it would not respond to control commands.

An on-site check on April 17 showed that the unit had power but would not respond to manipulation of the manual controls.

Voltage checks discovered an issue at the Power Pole distribution box that provides power to each of the site radios and control equipment.

The culprit was a fuse in the distribution box outlet for the two meter unit. The fuse was not blown but had gone into a high resistance mode. This provided enough current to show that the transceiver had power, but not enough for it to function. A new fuse cleared the issue, and all repeater function and control was restored.

The high resistance in the fuse might be related to the failure within the transceiver that was mentioned in the February, 2018 Waveguide (http://w8lap.com/waveguide/).
